1	<i>Babur</i>	Zahir-ud-din Muhammad	23 February 1483	26 December 1530 (aged 47)	----
2	<i>Humayun</i>	Nasir-ud-din Muhammad Humayun	17 March 1508	27 January 1556 (aged 48)	Humayun was overthrown in 1540 by Sher Shah Suri of the Suri dynasty but returned to the throne in 1555 after the death of Islam Shah Suri (Sher Shah Suri's son and successor).
3	<i>Akbar-e-Azam</i>	Jalal-ud-din Muhammad	14 October 1542	27 October 1605 (aged 63)	His mother was Persian princess Hamida Banu Begum.
4	<i>Jahangir</i>	Nur-ud-din Muhammad Salim	20 September 1569	28 October 1627 (aged 58)	His mother was Rajput princess Mariam-uz-Zamani.
5	<i>Shah-Jahan-e-Azam</i>	Shahab-ud-din Muhammad Khurram	5 January 1592	22 January 1666 (aged 74)	His mother was Rajput princess Jagat Gosaini. Built Taj Mahal.
6	<i>Alamgir</i>	Muhy-ud-din Muhammad Aurangzeb	4 November 1618	3 March 1707 (aged 88)	His mother was Persian princess Mumtaz Mahal. He married to Safavid Dynasty Princess Dilras Banu Begum. After his death, His younger Son Azam Shah became the King (for 1 year) .
7	<i>Bahadur Shah</i>	Qutb ud-Din Muhammad Mu'azzam Shah Alam	14 October 1643	27 February 1712 (aged 68)	He made settlements with the Marathas, tranquilised the Rajputs, and became friendly with the Sikhs in the Punjab.
8	<i>Jahandar Shah</i>	Ma'az-ud-Din Jahandar Shah Bahadur	9 May 1661	12 February 1713 (aged 51)	Highly influenced by his Grand Vizier Zulfikar Khan.
9	<i>Farrukhsiyar</i>	Farrukhsiyar	20 August 1685	29 April 1719 (aged 33)	Granted a firman to the East India Company in 1717 granting them duty-free trading rights for Bengal, strengthening their posts on the east coast. The firman or decree helped British East India company to import goods into Bengal without paying customs duty to the government.
10	<i>Rafi ud-Darajat</i>	Rafi ud-Darajat	30 November 1699	9 June 1719 (aged 19)	Rise of Syed Brothers as power brokers.
11	<i>Shah Jahan II</i>	Rafi ud-Daulah	June 1696	19 September 1719 (aged 23)	----
12	<i>Muhammad Shah</i>	Roshan Akhtar Bahadur	17 August 1702	26 April 1748 (aged 45)	Got rid of the Syed Brothers. Fought a long war with the Marathas, losing Deccan and Malwa in the process. Suffered the invasion of Nader Shah of Persia in 1739. He was the last emperor to possess effective control over the empire.
13	<i>Ahmad Shah Bahadur</i>	Ahmad Shah Bahadur	23 December 1725	1 January 1775 (aged 49)	Mughal forces defeated by the Marathas at the Battle of Sikandarabad.
14	<i>Alamgir II</i>	Aziz-ud-din	6 June 1699	29 November 1759 (aged 60)	Domination of Vizier Imad-ul-Mulk.
15	<i>Shah Jahan III</i>	Muhi-ul-millat	1711	1772 (aged 60-61)	Consolidation of the Nizam of Bengal, Bihar, and Odisha, during the Battle of Buxar. Hyder Ali becomes Sultan of Mysore in 1761.
16	<i>Shah Alam II</i>	Ali Gauhar	25 June 1728	19 November 1806 (aged 78)	The death of Tipu Sultan of Mysore in 1799.
17	<i>Akbar Shah II</i>	Mirza Akbar	22 April 1760	28 September 1837 (aged 77)	Titular figurehead under British protection.
18	<i>Bahadur Shah II</i>	Abu Zafar Sirajuddin Muhammad Bahadur Shah Zafar	24 October 1775	7 November 1862 (aged 87)	Last Mughal Emperor. Deposed by the British and was exiled to Burma after the Indian Rebellion of 1857.
