6	9th, 10th Muharram	Day of Ashura	Represent the 9th and 10th day of the Hijri month of Muharram. Coincide with the memory of the martyrdom of Imam Hussein.
7	117tn Ran1111 = 1	Prophet Muhammad's birthday	Commemorates Prophet Muhammad's birthday, celebrated in most parts of the Muslim world.
8	1st, 2nd, 3rd Shawwal	Little Feast	Commemorates end of Ramadan.
9	9th Zulhijjah	Arafat Day	Commemoration of Muhammad's final sermon and completion of the message of Islam.
10	, ,	Feast of the Sacrifice	Commemorates Ibrahim's willingness to sacrifice his son. Also known as the Big Feast (celebrated from the 10th to 13th).
